We are excited to invite you to partner with us for the "ARTepreneurial MOVEment" training course, a Key Action 1 project within the Erasmus+ Program. This project is dedicated to a specialized training program for youth workers, focusing on innovative educational methodologies that use art and sport as tools for enhancing the learning of entrepreneurial skills. During an intensive 5 or 6-day workshop, youth workers from various countries will gather in Puente Genil, Cordoba, Spain.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Venue:

Puente Genil, Spain

Participants:

24 pax from 8-10 different countries

Target Audience:

Youth workers, educators, project managers, NGO coordinators, and individuals actively engaged in entrepreneurship education, interested in incorporating art and sports elements to enhance engagement and innovative learning strategies. Age: 20 and above. Participating countries are invited to send 2 or 3 participants per organization, depending on the final number of partners involved. This training course is open to programme countries. Striving for gender balance is highly recommended.

Topics Covered:

- Integration of art and sport in educational settings to enrich entrepreneurship learning.
- Learning about the advantages of including art and sport when creating, operating, and educating about entrepreneurial ventures.
- Design and conceptualization of sports and creative activities with educational purposes for entrepreneurship.

Project Date:

The training course will take place from November 5th to November 11th or 12th, 2024. All project activities will align with non-formal learning principles, leveraging the experience of Europe2020 in managing and innovating educational projects. 5th and 11th or 12th of November will be travelling days.

Why This Project:

The "ARTepreneurial MOVEment" aims to equip participants with entrepreneurial skills and improve their entrepreneurial thinking by using elements of art and sport. This training course will focus on incorporating art and sport into education, guiding participants on how to effectively integrate these components into the learning of entrepreneurial skills and their future youth work endeavors.

Challenges and Needs:

People working with children and youths face the challenge of making learning topics and education more entertaining, interesting, and active, while still being highly effective, valuable, and useful for the future. Simultaneously, today's youth requires innovative approaches that resonate with them, and inclusion of art and sport can offer effective active learning experiences. Learning about entrepreneurship through these two ventures can equip youth workers with the necessary tools to actively enhance youth's critical thinking, decision-making, networking, teamwork, communication skills, and strategic thinking in entrepreneurship and at the same time include well-being and entertainment, enhancing remembering the learning topic.

Project Objectives:

- To explore, develop and share entrepreneurial competencies through art and sport activities required for effective and entertaining youth work.
- To foster innovative youth work practices, integrating game elements for active and creative youth education.
- To emphasize entrepreneurial thinking in youth through incorporating elements of art and sport.
- To foster the exchange of experiences and best practices in the field of entrepreneurship, gamification and active and creative education among partner organizations.

Travel Costs: Travel expenses will be reimbursed in accordance with Erasmus+ guidelines, considering the distance to the venue. For environmentally conscious participants, we encourage "green travel," meaning more than half of the journey should be by bus, train, or car. Please inform us of your preference.
