











WHAT IS THE PROJECT ABOUT?



Modern life keeps young people **highly connected to technology** but increasingly disconnected from the natural world. Many young people spend most of their free time on screens, which limits their opportunities to enjoy outdoor play, develop **environmental awareness**, and build a personal relationship with nature. This distance often results in less respect for the environment and fewer **sustainable habits**.

The Treehouse aims to change this by offering a unique experience where young people will spend a full week living together in a natural setting. Through workshops, outdoor games, and community activities guided by youth workers, participants will explore key concepts of ecology and sustainability in a fun and practical way.

TRAVEL


We will follow the Erasmus+ Programme Guide 2025 rules and use the official distance calculator to reimburse travel costs. Travle days are 03/11 and 09/11

To reach the project venue, the Ayuntamiento de Maracena will provide a private bus from Málaga Airport. Therefore, it is mandatory that all participants arrive at Málaga Airport on 3 November before 18:00. Ayuntamiento de Maracena will disscount 15 euros from each participants to cover the bus expensive

The journey to the campsite will take approximately 1.5 hours by bus. Please note that there is no public transport to the campsite, as it is located in a natural park area.

. Once the invoices and boarding passes are sent, the reimbursement will be done within 3 months






Project rules

During all daytime activities, mobile phones will not be allowed. They will be collected by the organizers and stored in a **silent box**. Phones may be used for one hour per day, before dinner, to contact family if needed.

We will encourage mixing nationalities during activities to promote intercultural learning.

All participants will be required to sign a Code of Conduct and commit to:

- Following at all times the instructions of team leaders and facilitators.
- Respecting the campsite, the natural environment, and the group's shared spaces.
- Maintaining a positive attitude, ensuring a safe and inclusive atmosphere for everyone.






What to bring?

To enjoy The Treehouse to the fullest, make sure you pack the following:

- Comfortable clothes for outdoor activities (layers recommended for warm days and cool nights).
 - Sport shoes / hiking shoes suitable for walking in natural areas.
 - ✓ Swimsuit and two towels one for swimming and one for daily use.
 - Raincoat or light jacket weather can be unpredictable.
 - ✓ Reusable water bottle stay hydrated and reduce plastic waste.
 - ✓ Personal hygiene items toiletries, sunscreen, insect repellent.
 - European Health Insurance Card (or equivalent travel insurance).
 - Personal medication (if needed, enough for the whole week).
 - ✓ National snacks or small souvenirs for the intercultural evening.
 - Positive energy and an open mind to learn, share, and make new friends!
