Beyond Barriers Association was created in June 2004 in Tirana, Albania with the initiative of a group of youngsters with and without disability. BBA is a non-profit, non-governmental organization that defends the rights and the interests of the young people. The mission of BBA is to empower young people in Albania by promoting active participation, inclusion, equal chances and better quality of life. Our moto is: "We believe in what we do!"

BBA staff is organizing a variety of activities in local, national, regional and European level. The focus of the association's work remains on young people with fewer opportunities, with the aim to offer them a chance for empowerment and to be active citizens of the community where they live.

Target groups: youngster with social disadvantages, youngsters with disabilities, youngsters from Roma communities, LGBT+ community and other young people in Albania. Special focus is on special target group which are young people with disabilities (all type of disabilities).

## BBA History with ESC

Volunteering and solidarity with youngsters in need is one of the main pillars of BBA work since its creation and volunteers themselves either local or international have been a great asset for development of the organization. BBA was involved in the previous EVS program, since 2006 and since then we have hosted in Albania around 200 volunteers from European countries in short and long-term projects.

Also, we have sent more than 150 young people from Albania in diverse projects in European organizations being one of the first pioneer of European volunteering in Albania.

Throughout participation in the ESC program, BBA offered to hundreds of youngsters an opportunity for development in personal, social and professional level.



## PROGRAM 1: "MIRËSEVJEN PARTY"

The volunteering team will take part in the organization and implementation of the "Miresevjen Party" (Welcoming Party) in Tirana — an annual event organized by BBA in collaboration with the Municipality of Tirana and several partner institutions. The event aims to warmly welcome new students to the capital city, showcasing the diverse opportunities, cultural spaces, and social activities Tirana has to offer. Through interactive activities, performances, and information stands, students will be encouraged to engage with the local community and make the most of their new environment.



#### **Volunteer Tasks**

Volunteers will contribute to the event by:

- 1. Event Preparation and Setup Assisting with arranging the venue, setting up stands, decorations, and equipment.
- 2. Guest Guidance Welcoming attendees, providing directions, and helping them navigate different activity areas.
- 3. Information Support Sharing details about activities, performances, and city opportunities with participants.
- 4. Logistics Assistance Helping manage schedules, coordinating with performers and partners, and distributing event materials.
- 5. Activity Facilitation Supporting interactive sessions, games, and workshops during the event.
- 6. Crowd Management and Safety Assisting in maintaining a smooth flow of participants and ensuring safety protocols are followed.
- 7. Closing and Cleanup Helping dismantle equipment, packing materials, and restoring the venue after the event.







## PROGRAM 2: ERASMUS+ DAYS AT BBA

The volunteering team will be actively involved in the organization and implementation of Erasmus+ Days 2025 at BBA, a multi-day celebration highlighting the opportunities and impact of the Erasmus+ program. This initiative will combine local in-person activities for young people with online promotional campaigns to reach a wider audience. Planned actions include interactive workshops, networking meet-ups, and information sessions, as well as engaging digital content such as podcasts, vox pops, and social media stories. The goal is to inspire participation, share real-life experiences, and connect local youth with the values of cultural exchange, learning mobility, and active citizenship.



#### **Volunteer Tasks**

Volunteers will contribute by:

- 1. Activity Coordination Supporting the planning and execution of local events, workshops, and networking activities.
- 2. Online Campaign Support Assisting in the design and posting of engaging social media content, including visuals, videos, and stories.
- 3. Podcast & Vox Pop Assistance Helping with scripting, recording, interviewing participants, and editing content.
- 4. Community Engagement Reaching out to local youth and encouraging their participation in both online and offline activities.
- 5. **Technical & Creative Input** Assisting with filming, photography, audio recording, and basic editing for digital outputs.
- 6. Guest and Partner Liaison Coordinating with speakers, alumni, and partner organizations for event and content contributions.
- 7. Promotional Outreach Distributing materials, sharing updates, and helping spread awareness about Erasmus+ Days activities.
- 8. Post-Activity Wrap-Up Gathering feedback, compiling highlights, and supporting the creation of a final event recap for publication.

The area is very lively, so you will be able to find many markets, shops, bars, banks, exchange offices in the neighborhood.


















#### TRANSFER FROM THE AIRPORT TO THE APARTMENT

Transportation services from the airport to the apartment are available. We can provide you with the contact information of an electric taxi company. You have the option to book your taxi either via WhatsApp or by directly calling them, and subsequently waiting at the airport for their arrival to pick you up (around 20 minutes). Furthermore, we will share with you the precise location of the apartment, enabling you to provide this information to the taxi driver. 
#### **LOCAL TRANSPORT**


The staff will provide you with an allowance to cover your local transport needed for the purpose of the activities. The public service in the city of Tirana is reliable and widespread. Tirana is a very busy city, and has more than 20 bus lines. All bus stations are located around Tirana Center, easy to spot and reach. You can find public bus from 6 AM-11 PM. It takes from 3-10 minutes to wait in bus stops for the next bus. The information about public transport is also accessible in Google Maps.












## Allowances



All volunteers will receive pocket money (6 EUR/day). Italians: you receive it from Link on your bank account before the mobility; Albanians: you will receive it from BBA in cash.

Upon your arrival to Tirana, you will also receive a budget of 10 EUR/day to cover your food + local transport expenses.

You will need to sign a form for receiving the money CASH.

The way you spend it it's up to you, we do not need bills for this expenses.

All ESC Volunteers are eligible to receive a Youthpass certificate at the end of the mobility:)









## Currency

## 1 Euro = 97,27 Lek

Albanian currency is called LEKË (ALL) but you can also pay in Euros at some places. Anyway, we recommend that you use Lekë. You can use cash everywhere and card in most places.

You can bring Euros with you and exchange them in Tirana Airport or in the city when when you are here. Keep in mind that you can pay your taxi ride in Euros or ALL but only cash!

1 Euro = 97,27 Lekë (it varies from day to day).

First, inscribe on the EU youth Portal, because to become an ESC volunteer everyone needs to be registered.


The only requirements for application are a CV and a motivation letter in English. Please send them via email.
