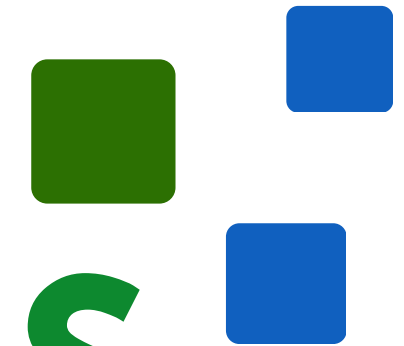

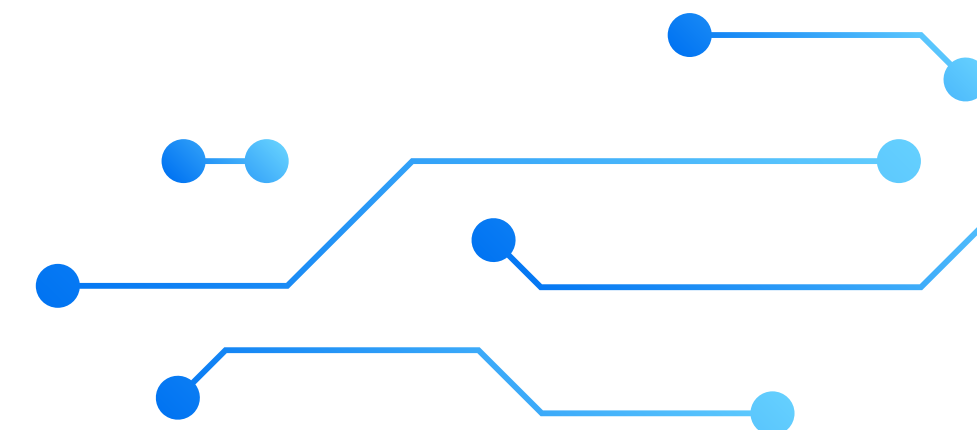

MAIN OBJECTIVES

To educate participants on environmental issues and sustainable practices through non-formal learning methods.

To help participants develop skills in digital storytelling and social media content creation, with a focus on sustainability messages.

To empower participants to become sustainability ambassadors, promoting positive change through digital media.

To encourage collaboration between young people from different countries, promoting intercultural learning and the exchange of good practices.

To create a lasting impact on both participants and their local communities by sharing the environmental content produced during the youth exchange.

AFTER THE PROJECT

- Each organization will hold an evaluation meeting with its national team to assess the mobility experience, what was learned, provide feedback, and help participants complete the Youthpass.
- Seven information sessions (one per country) will be organized with at least 105 participants in total (15 people per country). These sessions will aim to disseminate the results of the Digital Seeds project, the Erasmus+ program, and other training and mobility opportunities.
- Participants will create environmental awareness materials during the mobility period (such as posts, videos, or podcasts), of which at least six will be published after the mobility period ends.
- All partners will share photos and a video of the program on social media, along with a press release addressed to local entities to disseminate the project results.
- A multi-party online meeting will be held to exchange best practices, strengthen networks among youth organizations, and present the results at the European level.

TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT GUIDELINES

- Plan your travel from your place of origin to the Eleftherios Venizelos airport in Athens and return according to the travel limit.
- Your travels costs will be reimbursed up to the limit, on actual costs.
- Tickets and invoices/receipts are mandatory for the reimbursement.
- We will reimburse the account of sending organizations, and not directly to participants.
- Reimbursements of travel costs can only be made upon full attendance at the training course and the follow-up steps of the project.

TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT GUIDELINES



Ticket Documentation

- All boarding passes.
- An invoice for the flight ticket. The email confirmation does not replace the invoice.
- The electronic ticket with the travel plan or the email confirmation of the flight (the email received when the ticket was purchased).
- Return boarding passes can be sent after the project by post.

Reimbursement

- Before booking your tickets, you need to receive confirmation from the coordinator.
- Tickets booked without HYP's confirmation will not be reimbursed.
- Physical tickets need to be sent by traditional post.

The project will be held in Nisi.

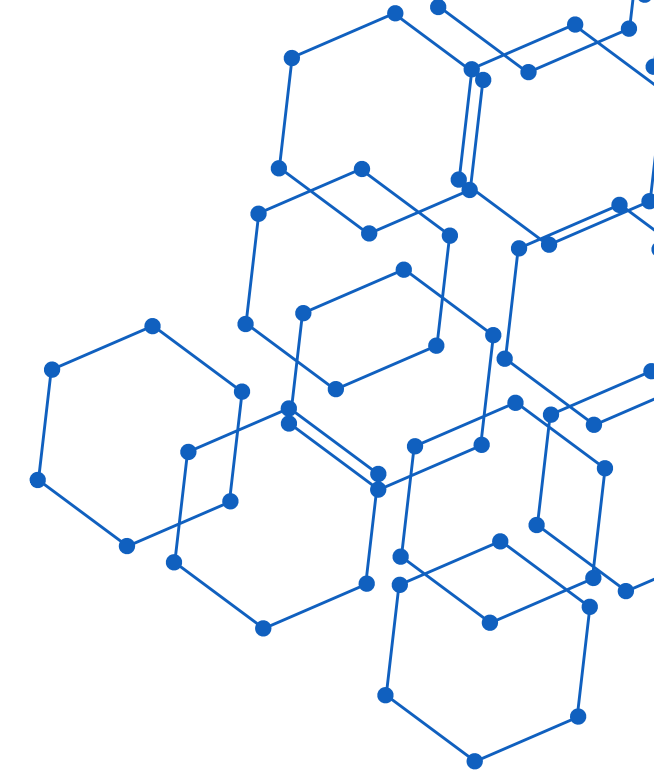
They will stay in Bell Tents of 3 or 4 people. Amenities are available, such as blankets, bedsheets and towels.
