about LINK

Our organization, Link APS, is based in Altamura and was established in 2003, working to tackle cultural, educational, environmental and social issues in Puglia and Basilicata by promoting international volunteering programs. Link APS believes in the opportunity that Erasmus+ offers to young people to broaden their horizon, learn new competences and become citizens of Europe.

Link also believes in the possibility for the local communities to get acquainted with new cultures and become more open to diversity.

In 2022, LINK decided to open its doors to even more youth exchanges through the Erasmus+ accreditation for this very reason; to offer this opportunity to more young people than ever before.

Participants' profile

We are looking for a group composed by 5 young people (17-22 y.o.) + 1 leader (+23 y.o.). We ask for genuine interest and care for the subject. We are looking for people who are curious, open-minded, and willing to truly engage with the issues surrounding fast fashion and sustainability.

We are looking for participants who feel the desire to live in a more sustainable way, who are ready to question their habits and reflect on the impact of their choices. Creativity is essential, not only as an artistic skill, but as a mindset. Creativity as a tool to imagine new solutions, new identities, and new ways of approaching fashion with respect for both the environment and ourselves.

The project envisages the participation of young people who have an interest in developing activities in the information sector aimed at citizens in order to raise their level of knowledge and awareness.

Participants should be:

- open to cooperate in an international environment, respecting diversity of opinions;
- able to work in English and other European languages.



About the project

Eco-fashion is the core focus of this project. Together, we will explore it through different tools and perspectives, addressing key themes such as fast fashion, sustainability, nature, identity, and appearance. Nature will play a fundamental role in our work, as we believe that everything starts from it and from the environment that surrounds us. Our goal is to understand how we can respect both the planet and ourselves within the world of fashion, creating a more conscious and responsible approach to clothing. Through this project, it is also important for us to engage and influence the local community, raising awareness about how fast fashion-related behaviors can be harmful, and encouraging more mindful and sustainable choices.

The first phase of the project will focus on awareness and education, introducing participants to the themes. This will be followed by a moment of self-reflection, where participants will be invited to question their own daily choices and habits, analyzing how sustainable (or unsustainable) they are and how they can be improved. The main objective of this project is to actively engage participants with the topic of eco-fashion, encouraging dialogue, exchange, and collaboration among them. We aim to create a shared space where participants can connect, reflect, and grow together, building a collective awareness around sustainability in fashion. Another key goal which is also the final phase of the project is the realization of an eco-sustainable event or party that represents the concrete outcome of the project and has the potential to influence and inspire the local community, spreading more conscious attitudes toward fashion and consumption.

Participants will sleep and follow activities at [Casa Nazareth](#), a facility surrounded by nature in the Apulian countryside near the town of Cassano delle Murge.

There is an indoor activity space, large outdoor spaces, a small forest, and a large kitchen with space for meals. Meals will be cooked by Link Association staff.

Participants will sleep in rooms for **6 people**. There is a bathroom in each room. Be careful, though, this is not a hotel: the spaces are very simple and somewhat old-fashioned. Also, there is **no wi-fi**. Therefore, we ask you for some flexibility, adaptability and willingness to step out of your comfort zone.



Financial rules

Travel, board and lodging expenses are covered by the European fund. Regarding the travel, the expenses will be reimbursed within the limits of the ceilings as foreseen by the User's Guide of the program Erasmus+ ([distance calculator](#)) and according to the rules of the Partnership Agreement that will be signed.

In the case you want to use GREEN TRAVEL option please contact us.

The project dates are **3rd - 11th September 2026**. If you want, you can arrive one day before the beginning of the project and leave one day after the end. In this case, the accommodation expenses for the extra-days will be NOT covered by the budget, so they will be NOT reimbursed.

To get reimbursed, you need to send us, at the end of the project, all the documents related to the travel (tickets, invoices, receipts etc.).

IMPORTANT

- Participants can arrive 1 day before and leaving 1 day after the project dates (3rd September - 11th September 2026). **The accommodation for the extra-days is not covered** by the project budget;
- In case of **green travel**, participants have 2 travel days for the arrivals and other 2 travel days for the departure. We ask you to inform us in advance in case you want to use green travel.

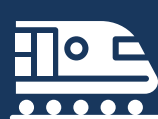

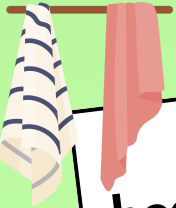
THEN
