## **Summary of the project:**

The project "Be Green-Be Solidar" is a continuation of another volunteering project completed on 31/3/2018: "Green Life- Choose your side!" The main purpose of this new project is to promote solidarity among the local community from Dragasani city and among 6 other rural communities in the south of Valcea county (Fumureni, Lungesti, Prundeni, Maciuca, Vitomiresti and Dobrusa) in order to protect the environment, active participation in the democratic life of the local communities and to promote social inclusion through solidarity activities.

In the short term, the project aims to facilitate the participation in a 12-month volunteering internship, 10 volunteers from the countries of the program and partner countries of the program to voluntary activities of solidarity in order to strengthen the cohesion, solidarity, friendship and European values among them. Also in the short term, the project aims to contribute to overcoming the situations of reduced opportunity faced by the participants and to contribute to their social inclusion including finding a job after the project is completed.

In the long term, the project aims at the following goals:

- to promote Dragasani-Valcea communities and 6 other rural areas, the spirit of solidarity, human values, democracy and environmental protection.
- offering alternatives for leisure for young people from local communities, including through sports and outdoor activities and ecological education activities.
- the social inclusion of the Roma communities in Dragasani, Gantulei, Strejesti and Dobrusa, including through the implementation of media and fundraising campaigns, which will draw the attention of local and national authorities to the problems faced by these communities.

### **Role and tasks of volunteers:**

- Attending the on arrival training session and the mid term evaluation session
- Specific activities within an info point on ecological education and environmental protection in Dragasani. Through this info point, the European Voluntary Service, the Erasmus + program and the promotion of ecology and environmental protection will be popularized.

A1: Greening Dragasani city (including the banks of the Olt river) and the greening of 6 rural communities in the south of Valcea county

A2: Planting trees on two hills belonging to rural communities: Fumureni and Dobrusa.

A3: Arranging a hiking trail on the vineyards hill of Dragasani and in Vitomiresti village.

A4: Organizing ecological education workshops in 4 schools in the city of Dragasani and another 6 schools in the rural area.

A5: Implementation of media and fundraising campaigns.

A6: Implementation of campaigns to collect electronic and household waste from local communities.

A7: Carrying out seminars, public debates and round tables with the theme of social inclusion of young people with reduced opportunities.

- A8. Selection of household and electronic waste and promotion of selective disposal of waste.
- A9. Performing non-formal activities in the center of the elderly persons from Dragasani.
- A10. Performing non-formal activities at the center of persons with disabilities from Vitomiresti.

In the solidarity activities 10 volunteers with reduced opportunities will participate, young people between the ages of 18-30 coming from 5 countries of the program and 5 partner countries of the program. Volunteers, supported by FCASEC staff, will prepare and implement the project's activities during the 12 months of the internship.

### **Practical aspects:**

The volunteers will work 6 hours / day from Monday to Friday. Their schedule will be organized as follow:

9.00-10.00: preparing the activity.

10.00-13.00: Activities.

13.00-14.00: Lunch break.

14.00-16.00: Activities.

The volunteers will have 2 days off every month, will have days off according to Romanian legislation and will have holidays according to the university year 2020-2021

The volunteers will be accommodated in private rooms in five apartments rented by FCASEC in Dragasani city at "Bratianu" hostel. The apartments are equipped with central heating, water, TV cable and internet. There are 2 kitchens fully equipped. Each apartment has 2 bedrooms and 1 bathroom. Totally will be 10 bedrooms and 5 bathrooms, 2 kitchens and 1 big room as common space.

To feed, the volunteers will receive a fixed amount at the beginning of each month, amount which will allow them to buy aliments and cook themselves. Also at the beginning of the month, all volunteers will receive a fixed allowance (pocket money). The local transport will be provided free of charge for the entire EVS period by FCASEC.

The volunteers will receive monthly 240uro (90 euro as pocket money + 150 euro money for food).

**BEFORE 4 WEEKS OF THE START OF THE EVS STAGE, IT WILL BE SIGN A MOBILITY CONTRACT WITH EACH VOLUNTEERS AND A LEARNING PLAN WITH EACH VOLUNTEER.**

## **SELECTION OF VOLUNTEERS:**

- Young people between 18-30 years old
- Boys and girls in equal number
- Young people ready to spent 1 year volunteer in Romania.

The deadline for finish the selection of volunteers is **31 March 2020.**

## **Validation of the ESC stage:**

Volunteers involved in this project will be awarded with a Youthpass certificate at the end of this EVS stage, which will describe and validate the experience of non-formal and informal learning acquired by each volunteer during their EVS stage period. The Youthpass certificate will be considered a process of awareness, reflection and documentation of learning during the different stages of the project.

## **HOST CITY:**

### **DRAGASANI**

#### 1. Geography and climate:

**Drăgășani** is a city in [Vâlcea County, Romania](#), near the right bank of the [Olt river](#), and on the railway between [Caracal](#) and [Râmnicu Vâlcea](#). The city is well known for the [vineyards](#) on the neighboring hills that produce some of the best [Wallachian](#) wines

The climate of Dragasani is temperate-continental with average temperatures of 10 to 11°C. The multi-annual average of rainfall is around 700 to 800 l/mp, and there are about 90 to 100 days of hard frost annually.

The town is situated at 220 km north-west of Bucharest (the Romanian capital).
