## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Maison Pour Tous Léo Lagrange is an organization which provide non formal education in urban area. The youth sector has 8 youth workers dedicated. 2 youth clubs are open 5/7 days after school. The volunteer will be in contact with teenagers every day through activities in youth clubs or in Schools. The MPTLL youth sector welcomes young people from 11 to 25 years old to support them in their needs, initiatives and projects.

International Mobility is one of the topics developed by the team.

In this topic, international youth exchanges, training to prepare and value the experience of international mobility and promote all the International mobility programmes (ESC, Erasmus+, OFAJ/DFJW) are the main activities implemented locally and regionally.

- DYNAMIC because in daily contact with teenagers so you will have to propose activities (linked with international mobility OR NOT) and spend with them in the youth club
- CURIOUS to discover new things, new people and talk with the teenagers
- CREATIVE to propose activities (always supported by youth worker)
- SOCIABLE to work in a team and with partners organisations
- SENSITIVE to environment, nature and sustainable development

A minimum level in French language would facilitate work and communication

## ACCOMODATION, FOOD AND TRANSPORT

You will live in Foyer des Jeunes Travailleurs not far away from the organisation.

You will have our own bedroom with private bathroom and fridge. You will have access to the FJT restaurant (small prices) for your breakfasts and meals during the week. It's also possible to cook and eat in the Maison Pour Tous kitchen. You will have public transport access thanks to a pass available for all your volunteering.

FJT is approximately 15 minutes by bus from the organisation.

## TRAINING DURING THE PROJECT

- Arrival and closure seminars provided by French National Agency
- French Lessons : learn the French language take part in french lessons provided by our french teacher with a group and on-line courses (2-4 hours / week recommended) during your freetime
- Participation to trainings with and for the youth workers team
