Crew is a Youth Exchange Project that aims to face the topic of social inequalities through the practice of *hip-hop* culture's disciplines.

The objective of the project will be creating a final *jam* where all the work done during the week will converge.







BROJECT RATIONALE

Hip-hop culture has always had a strong connection with the topic of social and economic inequalities. It was born as a subculture, grew up in the suburbs of industrialized cities, as **the voice of voiceless people**. Every verse, every step and every image that comes from this culture is the fruit of this history. It tells its origin and evolution.

Discovering the meaning of the art produced by hip-hop culture is a way to reflect on the social inequalities from which it arose and about how they are relevant today, despite the rapid changes in society.









The first edition of Crew took place in Altamura in May 2023.

In this project we will explore 3 of the 4 disciplines that make up hip-hop culture: *breaking, djing* and *writing*. Participants will be split into two groups: *group breaking* + *djing* and *group writing*.

In the morning session, followed by one tutor per group, the participants will work on the technique of the disciplines. They will practice and discover the culture from which they originate and with which they evolve.

In the afternoon session, the participants will follow nonformal education activities, **involving the whole group**, about the topic of social inequalities.





On Saturday evening all participants will perform in a final jam. An event where they will be able to connect with young people in the local community and exchange knowledge.

The event will feature live painting activities, a break dance and freestyle rap performance, all brought to life by the young participants.





THE TYTORS



Writing DONATO LORUSSO

Visual and street artist accredited with the most important names on the international scene. He currently works as street artist for public and private clients. Also, he's the art director of <u>Wallride</u> <u>Festival</u>, one of the most important street culture events in the national landscape.

Breaking and DJing STEFANO SLYMA

Stefano Logrò aka Slyma, bboy, Break Dance teacher, professional dancer and Hip Hop DJ of the historic Apulian crew *ToDaBeat*.







BARTIS BANTS

The project is open to **youngsters from 18 to 25 years old.** Each national group has to be composed of **5 participants + 1 leader (20+)**. Each group has to be **gender balanced** and internally divide its participants for area of interest:

Writing: **3 participants** Breaking and Djing: **3 participants**

We're looking for participants who're strongly interested and motivated in learning more about *hip-hop* culture and disciplines. We recommend the participation of youngsters with zero or little practical experience in the disciplines, since the courses will be provided on a basic level.









The activities will be hosted in <u>Agorateca</u>, a community library in the periphery of Altamura. This is the place where Link and its volunteers carry out their activities. Here the *writing and breaking* + *DJing group* will make their training activities.







The participants will be hosted in Oasi San Giovanni, a place in the countryside, ten minutes by car outside of Altamura. There is a kitchen, a large room for activities and eating together, a court for sports, and a garden where it is possible to do activities. The participants will sleep in a dormitory, with six persons per room. There is also a separate room for the leaders of the project. We will provide transportation between the accommodation and the activity space. Food will be provided to the participants, with the possibility to accomodate for special diets.

Good to know:

The place is spartan; bathrooms and dormitories are quite old-fashioned and there's no wi-fi. But with a little adaptability and flexibility, everything will be perfect!



HOW TO REACHUS



There are two chances from Bari Airport: one is by shuttle bus from (timetables <u>here</u>) and another one is by train. In this second case, you need to take the train from the airport (Bari K.W.) to Bari centrale and then from Bari Centrale to Altamura (information on this <u>website</u>). To get the train to Altamura you need to change the station. They are close to each other, the company is <u>Ferrovie Appulo Lucane</u>).



From another airport, the connection will be discussed with the organization.

FROM ANOTHER AIRPORT

> IMPORTANT: You **must** arrive in Altamura by 8 p.m. on May 4 and leave in the morning on May 13.





FINANCIAL RULES

Travel, board and lodging expenses are covered by the European fund. Regarding the travel, the expenses will be reimbursed within the limits of the ceilings as foreseen by the User's Guide of the program Erasmus+ (distance calculator) and according to the rules of the Partnership Agreement that will be signed.

In the case you want to use GREEN TRAVEL option please contact us.

The project dates are 4-13 May (**travel days included**). If you want, you can arrive one day before the beginning of the project and leave one day after the end. In this case, the accommodation expenses for the extra-days will be NOT covered by the budget, so they will be NOT reimbursed.

To get reimbursed, you need to send us, at the end of the project, all the documents related to the travel (tickets, invoices, receipts etc.).

IMPORTANT

- Participants can arrive 1 day before and leaving 1 day after the project dates (18 - 27 March). The accomodation for the extra-days is not covered by the project budget;
- In case of **green travel**, participants have 2 travel days for the arrivals and other 2 travel days for the departure. We ask you to inform us in advance in case you want to use green travel.
