Summary of the project:

"Green-Color of creativity" project is a follow-up of another volunteering project, implemented by FCASEC, during the period 01.02.2016 to 31.01.2017, in Dragasani and adjacent communes/municipalities. (see: www.greenrivers.ro).

In February 2017, along with partners and volunteers, the final report of this project has been carried out, and one of its significant conclusions was to continue the promotion activities for ecological education and the protection of the environment from Dragasani community, but also from the rural, bordering parts of Dragasani.

The specific targets of the project are:

- The attendance of 8 young people with fewer/inferior opportunities, from NEET category, to a 12 months EVS intership, on the protection of the environment and promotion of ecological education, in Dragasani community, but also in rural, bordering parts of Dragasani.
- The setting up of a EVS network of organizations (partner countries and countries of the programme), interested in promoting the ecological education, the network will provide the exchange of good practice in implementing the volunteering ecological education activities.
- Increasing the number of young people with fewer opportunities to 1000, they will receive ecological education during project implementation.
- Implementing „green behaviour” among the EVS volunteers, FCASEC volunteers and rural communities who benefit from the project.

8 volunteers from NEET category will participate in the work/activity of the project.

The main activities of the EVS intership will focus on promoting the environment and ecological education activities, which will be implemented by using various non-formal education methods.

The project results will be:

- Voluntary service for 8 young people from NEET category, 12 months intership, on the protection of the environment and ecological education.
- My web page and the facebook project page.

- The media campaign on the protection of the environment and ecological education.
- Foto exhibition, accomplished by using „photo-voice” non-formal education method.
- Network of interested organisations on protecting the environment. Network made up of organisations from Europe and organisations from partner countries of the project.

On long term, the project will propose a collaboration between the youth from the organisations in Europe and from the partner countries in the area of environmental protection.

Role and tasks of volunteers:

- Preparing a study on involving young people from their own communities in solving environmental problems and specific voluntary activities about environmental protection and eco-education. A comparison will be made between the participation of young people in volunteer communities and the participation of young people in the project community.
- Participation of volunteers at the on arrival training session organized by the National Agency.
- Organizing the launching conference of the project's activities. The event will be held on 25 April 2018 and will also be a debate with young people and local authorities on environmental issues in Dragasani city and surrounding areas.
- Greening activities implemented in Dragasani and surrounding villages: Gantulei, Stefanesti, Lungesti, Dobrusa, Gusoeni and Sutesti.
- Organizing 12 ecological education workshops in 2 schools in Dragasani and 4 schools from rural areas: Lungesti, Gusoeni, Stefanesti and Sutesti.
- Organizing 3 seminars about environment protection in 3 high schools (1 high school in Dragasani and 2 high schools in rural areas: Maciuca and Ladesti).
- Organizing a media campaign titled "Green-Perfect opportunity." This media campaign will promote environmental education, protecting the environment and finding solutions to solve environmental problems.
- Participation in the mid-term evaluation session, organized by the National Agency.
- Realizing and managing a Facebook page of EVS activities.

- Making materials to promote the project and ensure project visibility (posters, flyers, newsletters, articles in the local press). - Promoting Erasmus + and EVS.
- Creating and managing a web page for project.

Practical aspects:

The volunteers will work 6 hours / day from Monday to Friday. Their schedule will be organized as follow:

9.00-10.00: preparing the activity.

10.00-13.00: Activities in the national park

13.00-14.00: Lunch break.

14.00-16.00: Activities.

The volunteers will have 2 days off every month, will have days off according to Romanian legislation and will have holidays according to the university year 2018-2019

The volunteers will be accommodated in three apartments rented by FCASEC in Dragasani city at "Bratianu"hostel The apartments are equipped with central heating, water, TV cable and internet. There a 2 kitchen fully equipped. Each apartament has 2 bedrooms and 1 bathroom.Totally will be 6 bedrooms and 3 bathrooms for 8 volunteers and 1 big room as common space.

To feed, the volunteers will receive a fixed amount at the beginning of each month, amount which will allow them to buy aliments and cook themselves. Also at the beginning of the month, all volunteers will receive a fixed allowance (pocket money). The local transport will be provided free of charge for the entire EVS period by FCASEC.

The volunteers will have 8 free travel tickets per month from Dragasani city to Ramnicu Valcea city(the capital of Valcea county).

The volunteers will receive monthly 185 euro (60 euro as pocket money + 125 euro money for food).

NOTE:

BEFORE 4 WEEKS OF THE START OF THE EVS STAGE, IT WILL BE SIGN A MOBILITY CONTRACT WITH EACH VOLUNTEERS AND A LEARNING PLAN WITH EACH VOLUNTEER.

SELECTION OF VOLUNTEERS:

- Young people between 18-30 years old
- Boys and girls in equal number
- Young people ready to spent 1 year volunteer in Romania.

The deadline for finish the selection of volunteers is **22 December 2017**.

Validation of the EVS stage:

Volunteers involved in this project will be awarded with a Youthpass certificate at the end of this EVS stage, which will describe and validate the experience of non-formal and informal learning acquired by each volunteer during their EVS stage period. The Youthpass certificate will be considered a process of awareness, reflection and documentation of learning during the different stages of the project.

HOST CITY:

DRAGASANI

1. Geography and climate:

Drăgășani is a city in [Vâlcea County, Romania](#), near the right bank of the [Olt river](#), and on the railway between [Caracal](#) and [Râmnicu Vâlcea](#). The city is well known for the [vineyards](#) on the neighboring hills that produce some of the best [Wallachian](#) wines

The climate of Dragasani is temperate-continental with average temperatures of 10 to 11°C. The multi-annual average of rainfall is around 700 to 800 l/mp, and there are about 90 to 100 days of hard frost annually.

The town is situated at 220 km north-west of Bucharest (the Romanian capital).
